Saving Good Food for Those in Need

Legislation I worked on with my friend and colleague, Rep. Tarik Khan (D-Philadelphia), to increaseaccess to food donations has been signed into law.

One major obstacle to food donations from individuals and businesses is the fear of liability if someone becomes ill from the donated food. Many donors mistakenly view "best by" labels as expiration dates, even though these labels are intended to reflect freshness, not safety.

House Bill 615 addresses this concern by expanding civil and criminal liability protections to include donations of food that have passed the manufacturer's recommended date but are still safe to eat. This change aligns with recent updates to the federal Food Code and helps ensure more edible food can be donated rather than wasted. The person who donates the food must make a good faith evaluation that the donated food is good for human consumption.

This isn't a partisan bill. This is a people bill. Our legislation will help to provide more good food to people who need it.

The law encourages food donations and provides a critical link between surplus food and the more than 1.2 million people in Pennsylvania who are facing hunger, 325,000 of whom are children.
